FACE MASKS



THE LAA HAS RECENTLY RECOMMENDED THAT MEMBERS REQUEST THEIR MARKET CUSTOMERS TO WEAR FACE COVERING.

ENGLAND:

GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED 10 DAYS AGO THAT THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS FOR PEOPLE ATTENDING "AUCTION HOUSES" AND VISITING "RETAIL OUTLETS" WAS MANDATORY. I HAVE BEEN ASKING DEFRA TO CLARIFY IF LIVESTOCK MARKETS ARE INCLUDED IN THESE NEW RULES.

THINGS HAVE CHANGED

New Rules 2nd October Onwards

In view of the increased virus risk the following guidance has been introduced at Bakewell Market.

Facemasks are now **COMPULSORY EVERYWHERE** within the Market.

The <u>only</u> exception to this is whilst handling cattle, where the urgent need to warn others might be hampered by wearing a mask

In addition to all previous guidance we will be enforcing the following points:

- Children under 16 years cannot attend the Market. We are very concerned about the increased risk now that they are back at school. We hope you understand.
- A maximum of 2 representatives from a business or family is permitted around the ring to buy (we would prefer only one, but understand why this is sometimes a problem.
- Vendors of cattle may enter the vendor viewing area to see their cattle sold, but not for any longer period.
- 4. Vendors of sheep on sheep sale days may come in to the actual sale ring with their sheep as they are sold, or if they prefer watch from the vendor viewing area.
- Vendors and purchasers on regular sheep selling days (Mondays & Thursdays) must wear face coverings and maintain social distancing at all times.
- 6. Luck money instructions must be given in writing on the entry documents. Vendors <u>not</u> to enter the market office. No cash payments around the auctions will be permitted.

We appreciate that these measures will not be popular, however, they are being imposed to minimise risk to all concerned.

Please abide by them and help us all get through this very difficult time.

Vendors

There is <u>STILL</u> a "Drop & Go" System

- Animals must be delivered to the unloading docks (vendors must remain in their vehicles) whilst market staff unload the stock and collect the paperwork
- All paper work must be fully filled in, TB Test Dates, Any Reserves clearly stated etc Market Declarations can be printed off from our website
- Vendors should then leave the market premises. Payments by BACs will be paid in the usual manner, alternatively Cheques will be posted to you. You will not be able to collect these from the market office.
- Vendors are now allowed to return to the market ONLY to watch their stock sold. They must then leave the premises again. Please see details on Page 1.

For all breeding stock please let us know what you are bringing before hand

Buyers

Important notice for store cattle buyers:

If you wish to buy store cattle you must speak to Alastair Sneddon on 07973 982441 to register BEFORE you come to market.

- On Arrival

You will be asked to sign in, giving details of name, address and contact numbers and sign a declaration to state that you have not been in contact with a positive Covid-19 case nor have visited a high risk area during the previous 14 days

- Sale ring

The Sale ring area has been marked out to ensure social distancing of at least 2 metres apart.

Please follow the Government guidelines on regular handwashing. Face coverings are recommended for use when in the market.

NAMED SIRES

For the avoidance of doubt, we will only announce NAMED SIRES if the sire's tag number is printed on the passport, accompanied by the full name of the registered bull.

We will announce SIRE TAG if the there is a sire's tag number printed on the passport, but no name of a registered bull. You will appreciate that we do not have time to verify this information.

The details supplied to us on the signed entry form MUST be accurate, DNA tests are regularly carried out and the vendor will be liable for any discrepancies.

ALTERATIONS TO PASSPORTS

Please make best efforts to avoid sending cattle where there is the need to alter the passport because of incorrect sex or breed.

These matters should be corrected before sending stock to market.
