Unless an acceptable Banker's Reference is produced **PAYMENT IS STRICTLY CASH ON THE DAY OF THE SALE**. The Auctioneers reserve the right to withhold purchases until cheques are cleared.

**EAR TAGS** – All sheep must be tagged in accordance with the latest legislation for further help/information please contact the store sheep section at Bakewell.

We will provide you with only the UK flock number for lambs identified with a single Slaughter EID unless a full read is specifically requested at the fall of the hammer.

We will do our best to supply you with details of sheep tagged with full EID.  
However, we cannot guarantee the completeness or accuracy of this information.  
Please note the relevant addition to the Livestock Auctioneers Association National conditions of sale displayed in the market office.
